Show/Sale Requirements

All pigs must be sired by boars in stud at *Goldrush*. It is recommended that **all pigs weigh greater than forty (40) pounds. We suggest that pigs be clipped.** Classes will be divided by breed and sex.

All pigs must have standard ear notches. There will be 11 divisions: Duroc, Hampshire, Yorkshire, Crossbred (Dark & Light), Landrace, Chester, Spot, Berkshire, Poland, Hereford, and Tamworth. Each breed will show by sex. We prefer that pigs be born between **Dec. 1, 2011 through Jan. 15, 2012**. Purebred gilts farrowed after December 1, 2011 will be eligible for the *National Junior Swine Summer Spectacular*; barrows and gilts farrowed after November 1, 2011 will be eligible for the junior show at the *World Pork Expo*. Barrows and gilts farrowed after January 1, 2012 will be eligible for the Indiana State Fair.

A judge will sift entries to obtain a total between 100-150 pigs overall for the sale; so bring your best! Entries not making the sale will be the responsibility of the owner and they may be sold from your pens. Pens will be limited, so please prepare your pigs for small pen accommodations. Please provide your own bedding. Shavings will be the only bedding allowed.

Tagging - We will be using the crossbred ear tags issued from your vet as the pig's lot number. We will issue tags to all Purebreds as lot numbers and to any Crossbreds tagged with a metal tag. There will be no double tagging of pigs this year.

Entry Fee and Commission

The entry fee is \$25 per head and must be postmarked by **Monday, February 27, 2012**. FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY FORM. Late entry fees will be accepted after this date at *\$50 per head*. Please remember **all entries must be checked in by 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 10, 2012**. All entry fees are non-refundable. A commission fee of 7% will be charged on all pigs sold. Proceeds from the sale will be mailed to the seller within 30 days of the sale date. In case of insufficient funds and/or nonpayment by the buyer, settlement with the seller will be delayed until collection is secured.

Registration Papers for Purebreds

It is the responsibility of the breeder to make sure papers get transferred to the buyer of pigs in a timely manner. This has been a problem in the past. We request that all transfers accure within **30** days of receiving buyer information. This is to uphold the integrity of the sale. Failure to transfer pigs in a timely fashion can lead to penalties in future sales. We suggest that you bring the papers with your and give them directly to the buyer.

Cash awards and banners will be given for all breed champions. Additional money will be given to the Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Male and Female Overall.

Health Regulation Requirements

An official interstate health certificate of veterinary inspection from state of origin and issued by a licensed accredited veterinarian must accompany each animal. All animals may be listed on one health certificate. THE ORIGINAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE MUST ACCOMPANY SHIPMENT AND ONE COPY OF THE ORIGINAL CERTIFICATE MUST BE SUPPLIED FOR EACH ANIMAL. Each certificate must show: Name, address, phone number, and Premis ID of consignor, and be consigned to 2012 Goldrush Customer Appreciation Sale, Wayne Co. Fairgrounds, Richmond, Indiana. Individual identification of animal is required. All Crossbreds must have a federal approved ear tag, ear notches are acceptable for purebred animals. No health certificate needs prior state approval, but MUST use permit number **B120310**.

Health Papers Must Show

1. Since all states are Stage 5 of Pseudorabies (PRV) eradication program, notesting is required for this show. If the animals come from a Pseudorabies qualified herd and from a Brucellosis validated herd, it is required that these numbers and the last test dates appear on the health certificate.
2. All health certificates MUST carry the statements: NO RAW GARBAGE FED, HERD IS NOT UNDER QUARANTINE FOR ANY DISEASE CONDITION AND USES NO PSEUDORABIES VACCINE. ALL PIGS ARE VACCINATED FOR CIRCO VIRUS.
3. Remember, an original Interstate health certificate must accompany each shipment and each pig must have one copy of the original health certificate.
4. It is strongly suggested that all pigs be vaccinated for Mycoplasma, Erysipelas and Swine Influenza. NOTE: **All pigs must be vaccinated for Circo Virus and stated on the Health Paper.** This product is available commercially from several vaccine companies. This is not a state requirement.
5. SINCE THE STATE OF UTAH REQUIRES A TEST FOR PRRS, NO ANIMAL FROM THIS SALE MAY BE PURCHASED TO GO TO THE STATE OF UTAH.
